The listed courses are electable within the linked module. In accordance with available recourses the given compulsory optional modules my be attended repeatedly.
- 2. Individual compulsory optional modules: Students may create compulsory optional modules individually; the title and content have to be permitted by the study commission (Studienkommission).
- 3. Elective Courses: Freely electable courses (no approval needed!) in order to complete the required ECTS-workload.
